

Keeping Things In Perspective:

- A couple of sharp pencils (HB or 2B), eraser, ruler. A longer ruler will also be useful
- White paper (such as printer paper). A pad or clipboard for support
- Pictures of houses, buildings – different angles, interior as well as exterior views. “Hard copy” is essential for this study, *no iPads or cell phones*. (Real estate calendars are a good resource for house pictures)
- Glue stick
- One or two photo references for your next painting(s) which involve linear and/or aerial perspective. We'll begin laying out the drawing on (thin) paper. Know the size of the painting you want to create.
