“Wednesday Evening Life Drawing”

Welcome to the Wednesday evening life drawing! Have you ever done it before? Are you interested in life drawing instruction or just time on your own to draw? Instruction is available any time you would like. Please let your instructor know at the beginning of each class if you would like instruction.

The model begins posing at 6 pm sharp! If you would like instruction, please come to the school at 5:45 p.m. to setup and so you can receive introductory instruction before the model begins. If you plan just to draw without instruction, please come 10 minutes early to setup.

Materials List: Note: Drawing donkeys, easels, drawing boards, and clips will be provided.

For the first class, you will need:

- a pad of newsprint (18"x24" or 24"x36")
- a 6B pencil
- a white vinyl eraser,
- and a stick of soft black or brown conté or soft charcoal.

Other Materials: Feel free to bring other drawing materials you would like (e.g. coloured soft pastels, oil pastels and sticks, magic markers, pens, china markers, wax crayons, coloured pencils).

Wet Media: You are welcome to bring wet media such as watercolours, acrylics, and inks, but **NO** oils. Please bring your own brushes, water containers, palette, rags, etc.
