What fun we'll have creating art projects, playing games (indoor and outdoors) in our friendly professional environment. We will guide the children through various art mediums including collage, painting, drawing, murals, sculpture and more! Team building games, movies and outdoor activities. Daily outings to the Scott Aqua Park Splash Pad.

Location:

Summer Art Camps take place at the Kingston School of Art (647a Princess St. at Victoria), with daily outings to the Memorial Centre Park and splash pad, weather permitting.

Schedule and cost:

Art camps are offered in July and August, Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 4:30. Before and after care is available (8:30 to 9 a.m.; and 4:30 to 5 p.m.) for a fee of \$10 per 30 min. per child. The cost per week is \$250, and the cost per day is \$55. Four-day weeks, with holiday Mondays, are \$200 for the week. A child may be registered for a whole week or for individual days. Children must be between 5 and 10 years of age.

How to register:

You may register in person at the KSOA office, by phone, or through the website. Please print off the Children/Youth Registration Form (on the website and attached), complete it and bring it with you on the first day of your child's camp.

First Day of Camp:

On the first day of each session, please ensure that you bring any completed / signed / downloaded forms, and are prepared to supply any incomplete or missing information. Please use the Princess St. door to the school. There is a parking lot that you can use off Victoria St., just past the Window Art Gallery.

What Your Child Should Bring:

- A PEANUT/NUT-FREE lunch and snacks. While we cannot guarantee a peanut/nut-free camp, as we share public spaces on a daily basis, we make every effort to provide the safest possible environment for all our campers. Please assist us by ensuring that your child's lunch is entirely peanut/nut-free and that campers do not bring food to share with others. Please note that there is a refrigerator available for campers. The camp cannot provide cutlery. We ask that any food waste be taken home again by campers.
- Sunscreen.
- Sunhat.
- A refillable water bottle.
- Clothes that can get dirty/paint covered! A change of clothes is always useful- for many reasons!
- Closed-toed shoes.
- Hoodie or raincoat if weather suggests.

Art Camp Policies:

At the KSOA, we strive to provide a fun, safe and enriching program to all of our campers. Respect and fair play are always encouraged and the KSOA has a zero tolerance policy regarding violence and bullying.

Campers are expected to treat the teachers, studio and fellow campers with respect.

Campers are to arrive with open minds and willing hearts to engage enthusiastically in the creative process.

Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Campers who cannot comply will not be allowed to continue, and no refunds will be issued.

Cancellations:

As of the beginning of each week, there will be no refunds, transfers or credits issued.

Registrants may cancel, without penalty, up until 10 days before their first day, after which a \$30.00 administration fee will be charged.

If a camp week is cancelled because of low enrollment, registrants will be given at least one week's notice, and all attempts will be made to find an alternative week or be given a full refund.

There are no make-up days for missed days. There are no discounts, refunds or credits for days not attended.
