

WATERCOLOUR PAINTING ~ MATERIAL LIST

Suggested Supplies:

- Notebook/blank journal
- 18" x 24" newsprint or white cartridge pad
- Watercolour paper (140lb, 22x30" Cold Pressed 'Arches' recommended)
- Graphite pencils
- Black conté stick
- Watercolour paints (suggested) or any colours you have:
 - Cadmium yellow and Aureolin or any cool yellow
 - Permanent Rose or Magenta
 - Pthalo, Cobalt and Ultramarine Blue
 - Paynes Grey, Burnt Sienna
- WC brushes recommended (#12 round, #6 rigger, 3/4" flat, 2" flat hog hair)
- Water containers (two, large plastic)
- Large white Palette/white plate is fine
- Ruler
- 1" masking tape
- White eraser
- Roll of white paper towel
- Portfolio or 18x24" cardboard folder to carry papers

Optional:

- Drafting Brush
- Photographs

Please bring what you have to first class where we will discuss the supplies. You will most likely need more than one sheet of WC paper but wait to purchase until you need it as it is expensive and you may want to buy a different type. A set of 12 Pentel tube WC paints is suitable but you will need Magenta or Permanent Rose.
