## SUPPLY LISTS FOR OIL and ACRYLIC

## **Suggested Colours for Oil and Acrylic:**

- Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Red, medium or light
- Cadmium Yellow, med.
- Lemon Yellow
- Viridian a/o Hooker's Green
- Thalo Blue
- Ultramarine Blue

- Black Carbon or Ivory
- Titanium White
- Burnt Umber
- Burnt Sienna
- Yellow Ochre or Raw Sienna

Brushes: a variety of soft and bristle brushes, some good for both mediums, including:

- Filberts, #2-4, useful for a variety of brushstrokes
- Square flats, one or two larger brushes, for broader areas
- Small, pointed watercolour brush (#2) for detail

## **Other OIL Supplies:**

- Odourless 'turp' (solvent)
- Painting medium (can be mixed from solvent + linseed oil; bring small glass jar)
- Paper palette
- Small painting ('palette') knife (1"-1 1/2") for mixing colours
- Canvas boards are good for starters, then stretched canvas or gessoed Masonite
- Old telephone book for brush cleaning (some at the School)

## **Other ACRYLIC Supplies:**

- Acrylic medium and slow-drying medium (both optional)
- Water containers (margerine tubs, etc. Some at the School)
- Palette "stay-wet" with lid, or white styrofoam meat trays
- Painting surfaces (see oil)
- Watercolour brushes are good for thin acrylic applications
