Suggested Supplies:

- Notebook/blank journal for small exercises and notes
- 18" x 24" newsprint pad (if more than 7\$, do not buy/instructor will share)
- WC paper 1 sheet, 22"x30" 140lb, Cold Press ('Arches' recommended)
NB: inexpensive pads of WC paper are fine but not the best quality!!

- Graphite pencils (2H-hard and a soft "B" pencil - or any pencils you have)
- Black conté or graphite stick
- WC paint (suggested) or any colours you have:
 - Cadmium yellow & Aureolin or any cool yellow
 - Permanent Rose OR Magenta
 - Pthalo, Cobalt & Ultramarine Blue
 - Burnt Sienna OR Burnt Umber
 - Paynes Grey (optional - as you will make it)(Staples carries medium quality Staedtler set of 12 paint *TUBES* for \$10.49)

- Brushes (#12 round, #6 rigger, 3/4" flat, 1 or 2" flat hog hair)
NB: be sure to buy WC brushes – soft, shorter handles than oil/acrylic brushes)
- Water containers (two, large plastic)
- Large white Palette/white plate is fine
- Ruler, 1" masking tape, white eraser
- Roll of white paper towel, cellulose sponge, old credit card (cut up)

Optional:

- Photographs for last class

Please bring supplies to first class and be prepared to paint!
