It is nice if you have origami papers on hand. Origami papers are difficult to find especially here in Kingston. In case you do not have, here are some suggestions:

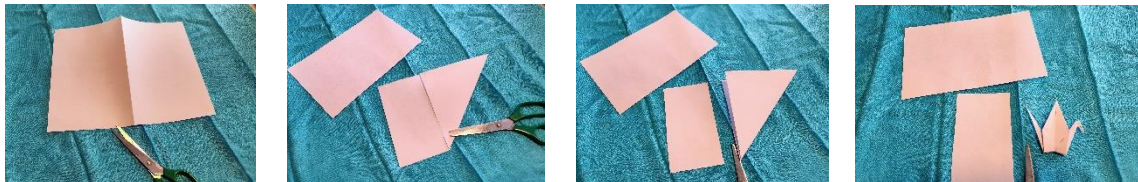
- 1) The regular size of an origami paper is approximately 15 x 15 cms. or 6 x 6 inches. Just before you throw to the recycle bin your weekly ads papers, kindly check if there are something you can find that can substitute origami papers. This week I found this catalogue. Very colorful, shiny and just perfect for folding. Let's make good use of it!



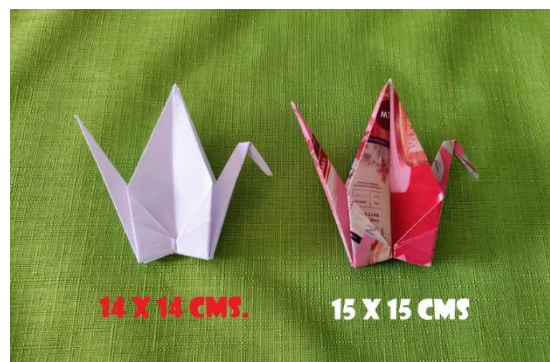
This catalogue alone would make

- 2) Another option is the use of A4 size paper, fold it in half and it will make two approximately 14 x 14 cms. paper.
